# **Regional Conferences**

The 2018 NCRC Annual Conference will take place in Fort Wayne, Indiana April 30- May 2. Our Theme is "Working Together for a Better Tomorrow." Our featured Keynote Speakers are: Carl Richie, NAHRO President, Adrianne Todman, NAHRO CEO, Joseph Galvan, HUD Midwest Regional Administrator, Unabyrd Wadham, Deputy Assistant Secretary of Field Operations and Kimberly Toler, Assistant Regional Inspector General for Audit Region 5. We have secured a sponsor for a Fort Wayne Property Tour to visit affordable housing developments and future development sites. The conference planning committee has put together a variety of sessions that build on NCRC's four guiding principles of Relevancy, Advocacy, Diversity and Developing leaders.
