SWRC NAHRO encouraged each of our States to promote Housing America activities within their respective communities and we received poster entries from 6 of the 7 States in the Region to judge and submit the selections to NAHRO.

Scholarships and Awards Programs:

SWRC NAHRO awarded 9 scholarships to Resident Graduating Seniors totaling \$9,500, with the top recipient Valeria Rocha, Cameron County Housing Authority receiving \$4,000. In addition, \$1,000 was awarded to one recipient of the Child of Staff category and \$750 was awarded to one recipient of the HOH/Resident category.

Southwest NAHRO Member Services worked hard at the conference and was able to raise more than \$4,000 for Scholarships through their activities!

There were 19 Award Recipients announced at the June conference, in addition to the States Member of the Year and Commissioner of the Year awards. We receive many entries each year and the committee has a difficult task to judge all the awards and select the winners! SWRC NAHRO also recognized Billie Shelburn, Burnet, Texas Housing Authority as the 2019 Charles Farris recipient!
