#### COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION AND DEVELOPMENT

## **Support for the United States Interagency Council on Homelessness**

Support a long term or permanent authorization and funding for the United States Interagency Council on Homelessness.

#### Status:

The FY 2017 omnibus funds the United States Interagency Council on Homelessness (USICH) with \$3.6 million and the program, which was set to sunset in 2017, is extended to October 1, 2018. NAHRO continues to advocate for the long-term or permanent authorization and funding for USICH.

#### **BOARD OF ETHICS AND CREDENTIALING TRUSTEES**

#### Revisions to the NAHRO Code of Professional Conduct Rules of Procedure

**Status:** The revised rules have been published at <a href="www.nahro.org">www.nahro.org</a> and BECT has followed the new rules in all appropriate situations.

### STRATEGIC PLANNING ADVISORY GROUP

**President Merritt:** Appoint a Diversity Equity and Inclusion Task Force.

**Status:** President Merritt has appointed the Task Force, which is chaired by Elizabeth Glenn. An introductory teleconference was held in early July; and "meet and greet" will take place at the Summer Conference.

**Member Services:** Study the creation of a standing committee for diversity, equity and inclusion, Housing America Task Force, Small Agencies Task Force and the Legislative Network.

**Status:** Vice President Donna Brown and SPAG Chair Mike Gerber have collaborated on a detailed draft document that describes the process, timeline, and member engagement for this initiative. The Member Services Committee will review/discuss and provide feedback on the document at its meeting in July so that work can begin following the Summer Conference.
