Associates: *On a separate sheet, please include the name, address, phone and email of your Associates. Dues: \$1.56 per unit with a minimum of \$100 and a maximum of \$18,000. Entitled to 6 associates plus one additional associate for each \$200 in dues paid with a minimum of 6 Associates and a maximum of 50 Associates.

PUBLIC AGENCY — A public agency, department or office interested in the programs and mission of NAHRO, i.e., community development departments, redevelopment agencies, state agencies, housing departments, city manager’s offices, federal departments, planning departments, etc. *(If the agency/department is also involved with housing and owns, manages or administers housing units, it will pay the greater of the dues for the public agency or as a housing agency - see above for rates.)*
