

**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS
2023 BIENNIAL ELECTION
NAHRO PRESIDENT AND SENIOR VICE PRSIDENT**

Who is eligible to seek office?

- Any associate or allied individual member may seek either office.

How do I declare my candidacy?

- Send an email to the Nominating and Election Committee Chair Diane Cohen (**dcohen@chelseaha.com**) stating that you are a candidate.

When and where can I announce my candidacy?

- The **earliest** date that you may announce your candidacy is at the 2022 National Conference and Exhibition.

How does national NAHRO expose candidates to members?

- Forums at national NAHRO conferences.
- Election News in the NAHRO Monitor and DirectNews.
- Candidates' webpages on the NAHRO website.
- From May-August 2023, candidates will respond to a monthly question posed by the N&E. Their answers will be published in the *NAHRO Monitor* and posted on candidates' webpages.
- NAHRO will send email messages on behalf of candidates during periods specified by the N&E.

Are there campaign activities at the regional and chapter levels?

- NAHRO encourages regions and chapters to engage in activities like the above-mentioned national NAHRO activities. Additionally, we suggest that Regions and Chapters provide candidates with publication deadlines and specifications for submission of material for their newsletters.

Who are eligible voters?
