





Alaska's villages are like tires: Hubs and Spokes

- We are not like the lower 48 reservations




















Homes lacking hot and cold running water, a tub or shower, or a flush toilet are considered to have incomplete plumbing.


In reference to "Color Clash: Strawberry Village" (Jan. 12):


I have nothing against developments, but I can understand the residents who live in expensive homes being upset because it brings their property value down.


