<p align="center">ROLE OF AGENCY/ORGANIZATION</p> <p>What was the specific role of the agency/organization in development, financing, administration of the program? What was the specific contribution, if any, of other partners?</p>	5 points
<p align="center">THE RESULTS/SUCCESS OF THE PROGRAM</p> <p>How did the program meet its objectives? Be specific about what was accomplished, quantifying as much as possible. What obstacles were overcome? Provide examples and measurements of the success, i.e. How many persons were served (percentage of resident population); Did it save money; or how did it improve delivery or services?</p>	14 points
<p align="center">THE TOTAL COST/FINANCING OF THE PROGRAM</p> <p>What were the operating and capital costs incurred in developing and implementing the program? What was the value received for the funds expended? Include a list of all the funding sources and the amounts. How were these funds leveraged? Are there any additional expenses that would be necessary to replicate the program?</p>	6 points
<p align="center">INNOVATION</p> <p>What is new about this program? How is this program innovative for an agency/organization of your size? If others have similar programs, what is your unique solution?</p>	6 points
<p align="center">ONGOING ACTIVITIES</p> <p>What plans does the agency/organization have to continue this program? If it uses primarily federal funds, what might be done if the funding is reduced?</p>	4 points
<p align="center">REPLICABILITY</p> <p>How easily could this project be replicated by another agency/organization in a different locale?</p>	4 points
<p align="center">CREATIVELY ADDRESSING A CHALLENGE</p> <p>What challenges(s) did your agency/organization face that promoted them to create this program? What was the unique solution your agency developed to face this challenge? What were the steps involved?</p>	5 points
<p align="center">DIVERSITY, EQUITY, AND INCLUSION</p> <p>Does the program address any social determinants of health such as encouraging agencies to become access points for economic stability, education, social and community context, health and neighborhood and built environments?</p>	4 points
